This Cookie Policy explains how Vibesynks uses cookies and similar tracking technologies on our web application. By using our web application, you consent to the use of cookies as described in this policy.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work efficiently, remember your preferences, and provide information to website owners.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

a. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the web application to function properly. They enable core features such as user authentication, session management, and security. You cannot opt out of these cookies.

- Session cookies to keep you logged in during your visit.
- Security cookies to detect and prevent fraudulent activity.
- Load balancing cookies to ensure stable performance.

b. Functional Cookies

These cookies allow us to remember your preferences and settings to provide a more personalized experience.

- Language and region preferences.
- UI layout and display preferences.
- Connected platform session states.

c. Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how users interact with the Service so we can improve it. Data collected is aggregated and anonymized.

- Pages visited and features used.
- Time spent on the platform.
- Error and performance data.

d. Third-Party Cookies

Some features of our web application may be provided by third-party services, which may set their own cookies. These include:

- Social media platform SDKs (Facebook, X/Twitter, LinkedIn, TikTok) used for authentication and publishing features.
- Analytics providers such as Google Analytics.

We do not control third-party cookies. Please refer to the respective privacy policies of these providers for more information.

3. Cookie Duration

Cookies may be session-based (deleted when you close your browser) or persistent (stored on your device for a defined period). Persistent cookies on our platform are retained for no longer than 12 months unless you clear them earlier.

4. Managing Cookies

You can manage or disable cookies through your browser settings. Note that disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of the Service. Most browsers allow you to:

- View and delete existing cookies.
- Block cookies from specific websites.
- Block all third-party cookies.
- Accept or reject cookies on a case-by-case basis.

For instructions on managing cookies, refer to your browser's help documentation.

5. Do Not Track

Some browsers offer a "Do Not Track" (DNT) feature. We currently honor DNT signals where technically feasible. Because there is no universal standard for DNT, our response may vary based on browser implementation.
